

Did you know?

The average military family moves 9 times over a 20-year career. With each move, military children face many school-related challenges. The School Liaison Officer is your advocate.

- Addresses issues with youth registration in the local school system
- Disseminates resources and information to families, commanders, schools and the community
- Validates transition concerns and connects families with resources
- Offers support for inbound/outbound school transfers
- Connects families with local school's points-of-contact
- Advises command on education transition issues
- Trains local schools on military children culture
- Educates local communities and schools regarding the needs of military children

Schools Can Receive Money For Military Families' Attendance.

- Ask about completing an Impact Aid Survey which can help a school qualify for funding.
- Impact Aid is used for a wide variety of expenses, including salaries of teachers & teacher aides; purchasing textbooks, computers and other equipment; after-school programs and remedial tutoring; advanced placement classes; and special enrichment programs.

PCS School Checklist

Parents/Guardian

- Student's birth certificate
- Student's Social Security Number
- Student's health record (immunization, physical, etc.)
- Legal documents as needed (guardianship/custody)

School Information

- Address/phone numbers of prior school
- Course description book/grading scale (if available)
 - School website (URL)
 - Counselor recommendation for placement

School Records

- Copy of cumulative folder/transcripts (official copy must be mailed between schools)
- Report cards, withdrawal grades, or progress reports
- Test scores (standardized or special testing, etc.)

Special Program Records as Appropriate

- Individual Education Plan (IEP)/ Individual Accommodation Plan (504)
- Gifted Program Description
- English as a Second Language (ESL) or Bilingual Education
- At-risk or other action plans for classroom modifications

Other Documents and Examples

- Activities records (extracurricular)
- Community service/service learning hrs

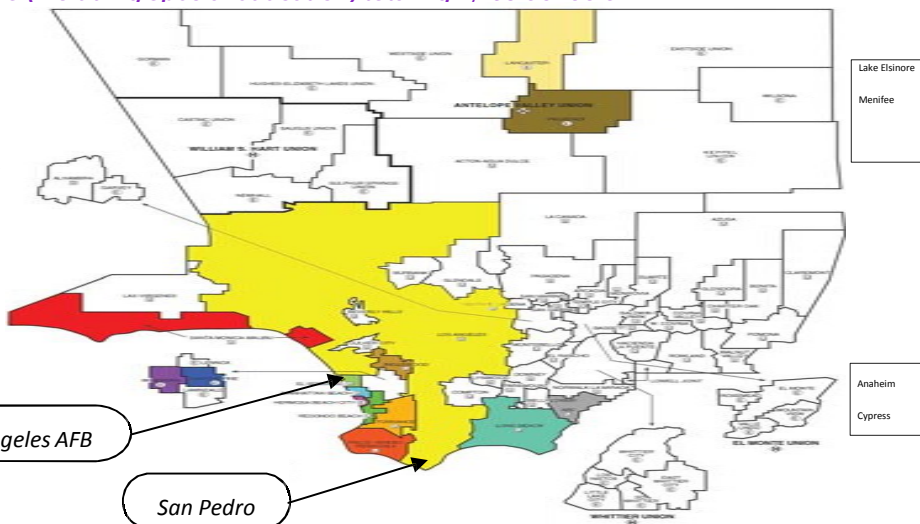

There are no schools or housing on LA AFB. Base housing is located 20 miles south of LA AFB in San Pedro and is privatized. If you choose to reside in base housing your child will be zoned to the 2nd largest school district in the US. The Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) serves 694,288 students and has 45,473 teachers.
